IV CONTRAST ALERT

- Kidney disease, single kidney or kidney transplant YES / NO
- Recent renal function (last 3 months) eGFR <30 YES / NO
- Previous Contrast Allergy YES / NO
- Diabetic - is the patient on Metformin YES / NO

CT Preparation

ABDOMEN AND PELVIS	No food or drink (except some water) for 2 hours. Arrive 1 hour prior to appointment for oral contrast.
BRAIN NECK CHEST	No food or drink (except some water) for 2 hours. Arrive 15 minutes prior to appointment.
CORONARY ANGIOGRAM	No food or drink (except some water) for 2 hours. Arrive 1 hour prior to appointment. Stop all caffeine, cigarettes and Viagra for 12 hours prior.
No preparation for spine, hip, knee, hand, wrist, sinus, dental and others.	

Ultrasound Preparation

ABDOMEN / AORTA / RENAL ARTERY	No food or drink for 6 hours prior to appointment. Small sips of water OK for medication.
RENAL / PROSTATE	Empty bladder 90 minutes before appointment.
PELVIS	Drink 1 Litre (4 cups) of water within 30 minutes.
PREGNANCY UPTO 16 WEEKS	Do not empty bladder after this.
PREGNANCY FROM 17 WEEKS	Empty bladder 90 minutes before appointment. Drink 500ml (2 cups) of water within 30 minutes. Do not empty bladder after this.
No preparation for musculoskeletal, thyroid/neck, scrotal/testis, breast and vascular.

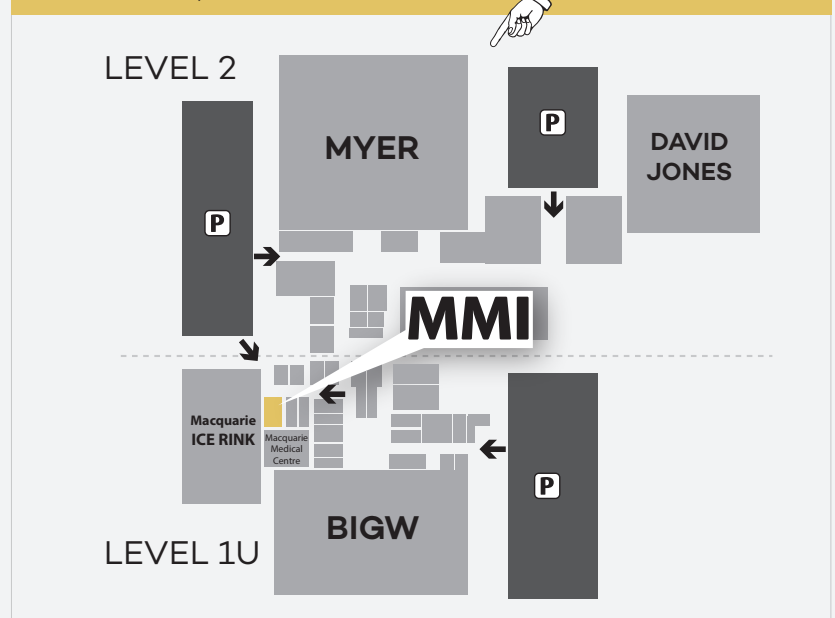
