# THE ROLE

Working under a revenue share license agreement, on a parttime basis, the successful clinician will be expected to provide high quality clinical assessment, management, and consultation to the Neurology specialty at MQ Health. Appropriate clinic space and practice management support will be facilitated.

Essential criteria include Fellowship of Royal Australasian College of Physicians or equivalent. Experience working with Multiple Sclerosis and headache patients will be highly regarded.

The clinician will be expected to have or be eligible to hold Accreditation at MQ Health and undertake teaching, research and quality assurance activities as appropriate. Opportunities to engage in clinical and/or laboratory research and more formal teaching are available to be explored through a formal or honorary appointment with the Faculty of Medicine, Health and Health Sciences depending on skills, experience and desired commitment.

### **EXPRESSION OF INTEREST PROCESS**
