### THE ROLE

Working under a revenue share license agreement, on a part-time basis, the successful clinician/s will provide high quality clinical assessment, management, and consultation services for ophthalmology at Macquarie University Health. Full practice management support will be provided. Theatre access is available for patients of all ages, including < 2 years.

Essential criteria include: Advanced Training in Ophthalmology, RANZCO Fellowship, or equivalent, subspecialty fellowship in paediatrics or glaucoma.

The clinician will be expected to have, or be eligible to hold, consulting rights at MU Health and undertake teaching, research, and quality assurance activities as appropriate.

Opportunities to engage in clinical and/or laboratory research and more formal teaching are available to be explored through a formal or honorary academic appointment with the Faculty of Medicine, Health and Human Sciences depending on skills, experience and desired commitment.

### EXPRESSION OF INTEREST PROCESS

Eligible persons intending to submit an expression of interest should do so by midnight on **2 July 2026** to [clinicians@mqhealth.org.au](mailto:clinicians@mqhealth.org.au) EoIs should include a CV and 1-page statement of suitability for the appointment, including any relevant previous experience.

Once applications are received, they will be reviewed, and interviews will be scheduled with suitable applicants
