Our haematologists use evidence-based methods to recognise blood abnormalities, diagnose conditions and treat and manage disorders. The clinic works closely with other specialists, providing a multidisciplinary and holistic approach to healthcare. We offer a fast-track service for urgent referrals, while non-urgent referrals are seen within two weeks. To expedite reporting (usually within one to two days), patients should have had appropriate blood tests and imaging prior to their appointment with the haematology clinic.

ABOUT OUR CLINIC

Our clinical neuropsychologists assess cognition, emotion and behaviour in individuals with neurological, psychiatric, neurodevelopmental or other medical conditions. Assessments include brain-related conditions caused by tumours, hydrocephalus, traumatic brain injury, neurodegenerative disorders (such as Alzheimer's disease and Parkinson's disease), stroke, epilepsy, multiple sclerosis, or autoimmune or metabolic disorders.

The findings of a neuropsychological assessment can play an important role in:

- establishing or clarifying a diagnosis or differentiating between two or more conditions (particularly if problems are subtle)
- determining cognitive strengths and weaknesses
- increasing understanding of the impact of a condition on an individual's level of function
- guiding return to work, study or rehabilitation planning
- identifying strategies that may assist performance and help improve quality of life
- demonstrating how well an individual is recovering from a stroke or traumatic brain injury.

Our neurophysiology department also conducts nerve conduction studies (NCS) and electroencephalograms (EEGs). Reports are generated same day.

AREAS OF SPECIALTY PRACTICE

- Neuropsychological assessments

Most assessments require two to three hours, involving an initial interview followed by comprehensive evaluation of thinking skills using standardised neuropsychological tests.

NOTE: Attention deficit/hyperactivity disorder (ADHD) and autism spectrum disorder (ASD) assessments are limited and have long waiting lists.

The clinic is affiliated with the Macquarie University Master of Clinical Neuropsychology training program. Patients can choose to attend an appointment with a student intern and supervisor instead of a clinical neuropsychologist at a lower cost.
