Opportunities to engage in clinical and/or laboratory research and more formal teaching are available to be explored through a formal or honorary appointment with the Faculty of Medicine, Health and Human Sciences depending on skills, experience and desired commitment.

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST PROCESS

Eligible persons intending to submit an Expression of Interest should do so to the Senior Manager, Clinician Practice Network at clinicians@mqhealth.org.au EoIs should include a CV and 1-page statement of suitability for the appointment, including any relevant previous experience. Once applications are received, they will be reviewed, and interviews will be scheduled with suitable applicants.
